
A605 East or West, turn to Cotterstock, drive through village, across first crossroads and then right at next crossroads (Glapthorn).

1 mile to venue from there.

On day:

- Parking is in Southwick Hall. This is at the entrance to the village (the far end if you travel from Bulwick), around 100m from the pedestrian entrance. You MUST display the car park permit in this area, which is otherwise for staff and volunteers only. Alternatively you can park in the main public car park.
- Go to gate and show permit (below). Go first to Junior Competition (in front of you at pedestrian gate) and collect white press bib, which gives access to all areas.
- Food and Drink can be bought on site with a wide selection available. Queues can get large at lunchtime.
- Please report any concerns or issues to the Control point (information & souvenir) tent for resolution (on left just before entering the gravelled area).
- Police/First Aid and Blind dog stalls are all adjacent to the control point.
- A gazebo is available in the main arena for press use.

Please remember to return your white press bib to any steward at the end of the event.



If you have to be near your vehicle:

Disabled parking Zone 3 (There is a marked press area). Note, there is limited parking in this area.

At Southwick (from Oundle or Peterborough), Prior to 09:30, drive down the main street rather than go in the public car park entrance. Drive past the pub and village hall and turn left at the 'no entry' sign (enter with caution). Park up at the bottom of the field nearest entrance. Display the car park permit (below). After 09:30, enter through the main car park, show the steward your accreditation (this document), and they will direct you.

Filming/ photographing: Permissions

- Notices are displayed at entrances in which anyone entering the ground is informed that photography and filming for public use is taking place, and further permissions may not be requested.
- It is only possible to enter the adult competition by giving specific permission to be photographed/ filmed
- It is expected parental permissions are sought if naming any U-16

Filming/ photographing: Sites

 Announcer's tower. No more than one additional person is allowed at the top of the tower. If you wish to film or photograph from here, please ask the steward on duty to organise for you.

Emergency Access

- No drones. If putting up a device outside the exclusion zone, please inform stewards.
- Arenas. Full access allowed to both adult and junior arenas. Please take care to allow the audience a good view, and to allow stewards to carry out their roles. A gazebo is available for shelter at the adult competition
